Wednesday 9 July – Sports Day

You are cordially invited to join us for our annual sports day which is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 9 July. All children will be taking part in the day's events.

Nursery a.m. children/infant sports are due to begin at 9.15am and will go on throughout the morning session. Sporting events will continue after lunch at 1.00pm with Nursery p.m./junior sports and will go on throughout the afternoon.

The children will be provided with drinks throughout the day. There will therefore be no necessity for parents to purchase drinks for individual children. The children will also be given an ice cream during the lunchtime break.

In case of the weather being very warm please ensure that your child is equipped with a sun hat, sun cream and a bottle of water that is clearly labelled with their name.

In case of inclement weather conditions on 9 July an alternative day has been set for <u>Friday</u> <u>11 July.</u> Please note that this is a change of date from the alternative sports day that has previously been published. We have been notified that the National Union of Teachers and members of support staff unions will be taking industrial action on 10 July. This means that these unions are calling out the majority of teaching and non- teaching staff of St. Michael's Academy, and events that were scheduled to take place on 10 July will have to be cancelled. Hopefully the weather will be kind to us on 9 July and sports day will go ahead on the first date that has been identified. During the day members of the PTA will be serving hot and cold drinks. The PTA will gratefully receive any donations of homemade cakes and other food items which may be sold on sports day. Thank you for your help and support. In order to protect the safety of children, parents are asked to leave the school site once the infant sports have ended. Junior sporting events are scheduled to commence at 1.00pm and parents are asked to arrive at school at 12.50pm once the children have returned to class and the main gates have been re-opened. Thursday 10 July – Catholic Primary Schools' musical celebration

On this evening some of our pupils were due to take part in a music festival that was to be hosted at St. Edmund's Academy. Unfortunately due to the proposed industrial action that is now scheduled to take place on 10 July the concert will either be re-scheduled or the decision will be taken to cancel the event.

Thursday 10 July – Advance notification of proposed STRIKE ACTION

We have been informed by the National Union of Teachers and support staff union Unison that they will be taking industrial action in the form of a strike on Thursday 10 July. This means that these unions are calling out the majority of the teaching staff of St. Michael's Academy.

This action is not against St. Michael's Catholic Primary Academy & Nursery itself but is part of regional/national industrial action organised by these unions about changes to the pension schemes of their members.

There is no requirement on unions to inform us as to which members of staff will take action. On this occasion, due to the goodwill and professionalism of those called to take industrial action, we do know in advance the scale of the action and how it will affect St. Michael's.

Neither Bishop Cleary Board of Directors, nor St. Michael's Academy Committee or myself as the Principal of St. Michael's is legally allowed to close the academy 'in sympathy' with the strike and we would never do this. However, our main concern is for the provision for our pupils. In making assessment it is my view that appropriate provision for pupils will be severely compromised and thus it will not be possible for children to attend on this day. **St. Michael's Catholic Primary Academy and Nursery will therefore be closed to all children on Thursday 10 July 2014.**

If the action is extended, or repeated, St. Michael's will endeavour to protect children's education. However, as I am sure you know, non-striking colleagues do not take classes for colleagues who are participating in strike action. Should there be any changes to the positions of unions prior to the 10 July and it is determined that the action will be withdrawn, I will inform parents of the change in position.
