### **Christmas Productions**

Tickets for the various Christmas performances will be on sale from Monday 1 December, and will be available from the school office before and after school each day. Tickets are priced at £1.00 each. Tickets are limited to two per family for some performances.

Admission to the performances will be by ticket only, and parents are advised to buy their tickets early as fire regulations apply to the number of people who can be admitted to each performance. Any children attending one of the performances as a member of the audience will also require a ticket and will be counted in the number of persons against the fire safety regulations to which we must comply. Clearly we would wish to avoid any disappointment that a refusal of admission may create.
